RE: SOUTHERN NEVADA MASTER LABOR AGREEMENT/2022-2025

Dear Mr. Velasquez:

As a result of the June 8, 2024, General Membership Meeting and the negotiated increase in the amount of Four Dollars (\$4.00), as indicated below, the following wage rates and fringe benefits were agreed to and will be distributed as follows:

Effective July 1, 2024, the Health and Welfare Fund will be increased thirty-five cents (35¢), to Thirteen Dollars and thirty cents (\$13.30), for all hours worked or paid.

The Pension contribution will be increased fifty cents (50¢), to Ten Dollars and sixty-five cents (\$10.65), for all hours worked or paid.

The Defined Contribution Plan (Annuity) will be increased fifty cents (50¢), to Five Dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50), for all hours worked or paid.

The Vacation-Holiday amount of One Dollar and seventy-five cents (\$1.75) will remain the same and the Supplemental Dues amount will be increased ten cents (10¢) to One Dollar and seventy cents (\$1.70), making the total Vacation-Holiday contribution Three Dollars and forty-five cents (\$3.45), for all hours worked or paid.

The Joint Apprentice Training/Journeyman Retraining Fund will be increased five cents (05¢), making a total of ninety-five cents (95¢), for all hours worked or paid.

Effective October 1, 2024, the Hourly Wage Rates will be increased a total of Two Dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50), as noted below.

Zone Pay (Refer to Article XVIII, Paragraph Q). Zone Pay shall apply as follows and shall become the base rate for the entire shift, for jobs that start on or after July 1, 2022:

- From the City Hall of Las Vegas, Nevada -
- 0 to 45 Miles – Free*
- 45 Miles to 60 Miles - add \$4.00 per hour to wage rates*
- 60 Miles and over - add \$4.50 per hour to wage rates*

Apprentices operating equipment set forth in Group XIII through XXV of Appendix A will receive the applicable wage rate for that Group.

0- 999	hours	-	Step I	@ 60%
1000-1999	hours	-	Step II	@ 65%
2000-2999	hours	-	Step III	@ 70%
3000-3999	hours	-	Step IV	@ 75%
4000-4999	hours	-	Step V	@ 80%
5000-6000	hours	-	Step VI	@ 90%

All shift pay or premiums entitled to be paid under the terms of this agreement shall be paid in full and added to the Apprentice Base Wage Rate, for all hours worked or paid.

At no time shall the above apprentice wage rates exceed any of the Journeyman Group Rates of this agreement.

Effective October 1, 2022, it was agreed in negotiations the additional pay for Operators on hoists with three (3) drums will be increased from fifteen cents (15¢) to fifty cents (50¢) per hour. The additional pay shall be added to the regular rate of pay and become the base rate for the entire shift.

Effective July 16, 2007, it was agreed in negotiations the Foreman pay will be increased from One Dollar and twenty-five cents (\$1.25) to Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour.

Effective July 1, 2001, it was agreed in negotiations the hazardous material pay will be increased from One Dollar (\$1.00) to Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour.
